LEARN TO PAINT EXPRESSIVE ARTWORK USING MIXED MEDIA with Laura Reiter

UNDERPAINTING AND TEXTURED EFFECTS

Underpainting is a way of losing the white of your canvas or paper by beginning with painting a bright colour over the whole surface, thereby creating a tonal base for your picture from which you can more easily map out lights and darks and helping to create a 'sparkle' to your image. This workshop will be based on quite a busy textured landscape such as a field of flowers, spring meadow or even beach scene. We will work from photos as starting points and investigate different ways of creating a lively image. Materials can include acrylic paints\inks, oil pastels, collage etc.

WEDNESDAY 9TH FEBRUARY And WEDNESDAY 16TH FEBRUARY

A LOOK AT HENRI MATISSE

Known for flat, patterned fields of saturated colour and a sense of space which is also flattened, Henri Matisse was one of the most influential artists of the 20th Century. For this workshop we will look at his methods and style using still life as subject matter simplifying form, heightening colour and flattening spaces on the picture plane. As well as learning about his techniques and design, it will also be a lot of fun learning from this master. Materials will be acrylic paints on canvas or paper.

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WEDNESDAY 2ND MARCH And WEDNESDAY 9TH MARCH

BUILDINGS AND ABSTRACTION

Using parts of pictures of different buildings we will create a starting point for making abstract images with geometrical, textured and linear leanings. (Although no maths skills will be needed!). We will look at grids, colour and composition and use a variety of mixed media. Maybe get your rulers ready!

The fee for each two-week block will be £30.00 or £80.00 if you book for all three workshops together.
